Novae Attendance Policy

Students are expected to be present whenever possible. However, the CHS Choral Department understands that students have many worthwhile experiences from which to choose during their time in school. Conflicts with other events often arise and circumstances come to bear that sometimes require an absence. This year we are requiring **75% attendance** at rehearsals, with limited exceptions, see below. While we don't require 100% attendance, we do ask for 100% accountability, if a rehearsal is missed, excused or not, we ask that you make an effort to figure out what was missed, and keep pace with the rest of the group.

Excused Absences

- Illness or medical emergency
- Death in family
- Participation in a **previously planned** major family event (wedding, religious ceremony, reunion, etc.)
- All excused absences must be reported to Mr. Jackson and Miss Meyer

Unexcused Absences

- No call/no show to rehearsal, dress rehearsal, or performance
- No prior notice of conflict
- Work (Failure to give your boss proper notice of a rehearsal/performance that has been on our calendar for months is not an excuse.)
- Babysitting – make family arrangements to accommodate your schedule as a student.
- Out-of-town visitors (“But it’s the ONLY TIME I can see uncle Fred”)
- “But I couldn’t get a ride...”
- Routine appointments that can be scheduled for other times (dental/eye exams, doctor checkups, driving school, etc.)

An unexcused absence from a major performance/concert or below 75% attendance (see exceptions above) to rehearsal **will result in removal from the ensemble** with no financial refund. Major performances are those that have been on the calendar all year.

Excused Absence Procedure

- Any potential conflict must be communicated (text/call/email/Square) to Mr. Jackson and Miss Meyer ***two weeks prior*** to the absence (except in cases of accident or medical emergency). You must receive feedback/approval before the absence is considered excused.

Conflicts with Other CHS Activities

- We do not want your participation in Novae to unequivocally preclude you from engaging with and developing other talents at CHS (i.e. sports, clubs, theater), and we will work to determine the best solution if/when potential conflicts arise. Letting us know ASAP about schedules of conflicting activities will help us work out a plan for attendance. However, life is about balancing priorities, and being a member of Novae is being a member of a team - and you will have 13-20 other members depending on you. Remember the timeline of your commitments.

Dues

- \$600* per student, which covers
 - Nordonia a Cappella Festival, Kettering Acafest, travel, and workshop fees*
 - Arrangement Costs
 - Costs associated with recording
 - Novae T-Shirt
 - Various non-budgeted incidentals
- The Novae fee does **NOT** cover the National A Cappella Convention and Disney trip to Florida. For further information on costs, fundraising, and logistics, please attend the Parent Choir Meeting (see below).
- Dues can be paid in full or split into two payments, due by September 6, 2022 and January 4, 2023

*Please see Mr. Jackson, Miss Meyer, or Mrs. Korpusik with any financial concerns. If you want to be a part of Novae, we will not permit fees or dues to stop you.

Fundraising

- Group fundraising opportunities are provided through the school to help with travel expenses.
- Novae specific fundraising (if desired) will be handled by Novae parents. In the past, successful events like “restaurant takeovers” and car washes have proven lucrative.
- Obviously, the more money raised, the more money can be applied toward either recording or travel expenses.

Solo Auditions

- Solo Auditions - when requested they can be recorded using any audio recording device (phone, computer, etc) and submitted to Trey and Kathy in Square.

Intra-Group Correspondence

- Square app - Novae will use Square, the platform CHS is using for parents and students to communicate with teachers, coaches, etc.
- Google Drive - We also have a Novae Google Drive to share music, documents, and audio files. This is most easily accessible if you have an existing google account (CHS email blocks access to Google Drive and folders.), but we should soon be transitioning to a Drive connected with CHS emails.

Rehearsal Schedule

- Novae meets two evenings per week on Mondays & Wednesdays from 5-7pm.
- Impromptu Rehearsals - Only when necessary to prepare for upcoming performances.
